Speaker: Dale Ford:
“My Two Hot Wars & One Cold War”



Dale Ford is a former United States Air Force fighter pilot and Flight Test Engineer with Convair working on the B-58 Hustler. Dale joined the peacetime Air Force in 1949, and two days after he graduated from flying school the Korean War began. He soon found himself over the Korean Peninsula in an F-86 conducting over 100 combat missions against the MiG-15 with the 4th & 51st Fighter Interceptor Wings. Mr. Ford pursued his aviation interest after his Air Force time by graduating from Purdue University with a degree in aeronautical engineering and joining the Convair Aeronautical Corporation in 1956. He spent the next five years working closely with and flying with the B-58 test pilots as a flight test engineer, taking the four-engine, 163,000-pound aircraft to twice the speed of sound and proving it ready for production for the U.S. Air Force.

Mr. Ford recently authored his exploits in a book with the above title, and will be available for book signing following the presentation. The cost of the book is \$12.00.
